GOVERNMENT RESOURCES

Register with FEMA

Anyone affected by Sandy (homeowners, renters, and businesses) can apply for federal disaster assistance. Register at www.disasterassistance.gov or by calling FEMA at 800-621-3362.

Non-English and non-Spanish speakers may call 866-333-1796 for translation services in 18 languages. The new deadline to register is *March 29th, 2013*.

Apply for an SBA Loan

You must apply for an SBA loan to be eligible for FEMA assistance that covers personal property, vehicle repair or replacement, and moving and storage expenses. To apply for a low interest loan call the SBA Customer Service Center at 800-659-2955 (800-877-8339 for the deaf and hard-of-hearing). Visit <http://disasterloan.sba.gov/ela> to apply online. The new deadline to register is *March 29th, 2013*.
